

Embroidered Sewing Kit

Supply list for first class only, The rest of the supply list will be provided on that in the first class, along with the pattern and options for your inside pockets:

1 fat quarter of wool for the outside of your kit 12X30

1 fat quarter of wool for the inside of your kit 12X30
This isn't necessary for the 1st class, but you might just want to have it so you can coordinate your kit.

Assorted Embroidery and tapestry needles

Scissors, thread to match your tree trunk

Pictures of your favorite trees to use as inspiration

Any embroidery threads, silk ribbon, perle cottons, wool pieces, notions, or embellishments that you might want to use on the cover of your sewing kit.

A receipt showing you've purchased your own copy of Carolyn Pearce's book, *The Embroidered Village Bag*,* and at least page 24 printed off. If you do not have a printer and cannot print this page, show us your receipt and I will provide you a copy. This is a copyright issue,

but you'll love this wonderful resource book with more great things than I could possibly teach.

Any yarn, thread, perle cotton, thin ribbons that you want to use in your tree trunk and branches.

Remember that the more you have, the less each one matters, so bring a wide assortment, and I will have some as well to choose from.
